Crescent Bay Pony Club is proud to host the Zone 1 Standard & Rating Clinic 2009. Sarah Morgan, graduate A pony club member and current National Examiner will be the clinician. This focus of this clinic will be on understanding the expectation of the USPC Standards of Proficiency from the D1-C2 level. Club leaders, instructors, parents who are looking for a better understanding of the Standards are invited to attend. Those wishing to be listed on the Old Dominion Resource List of Instructors and Rating Examiners are expected to attend this clinic. Active pony club members who are preparing for the HB or above rating are strongly encouraged to attend so that they will have a clearer picture of the different rating levels and how to approach the teaching for each of those levels.

Location: Arbor Gate Farm, 3943 Dawley Road, Virginia Beach, Virginia 23457

Cost: Registration fee: \$20. This clinic is free to active pony club members of the USPC and the ODRPC. All active pony club members must be accompanied by a responsible adult OR have an original signature Medical Release form on file with Erin Brown. No refunds. Clinic fee includes all handouts.

Closing Date: RSVP by 10/1. Clinic registration may be sent by snail mail or electronically. Those sent by snail mail must be postmarked by 10/1. For those sent electronically the date of notice must also be by 10/1. Follow snail mail registrations with an email or phone call to Erin. Checks can be club or personal check and are to be payable to ODRPC. For those registering electronically the registration fee can be paid upon arrival at the clinic site. There will be no refunds. Upper Level members attending this clinic must have original signature Medical Release on file with Erin by the date of clinic.

Directions: From I-64 East: take the Indian River Road East exit. You will follow Indian River Road for about 20 minutes. Pass through the light at North Landing, and after a couple of miles you will see a flashing yellow light at West Neck Road. Turn right onto West Neck and follow it until it dead ends at Princess Anne Road and turn left. Take your first right onto Pleasant Ridge Road. Take your first right onto Dawley. Arbor Gate Farm is located at 3943 Dawley Road.

Attire: Dress appropriately for the weather. The clinic will be held in an indoor arena so you will be protected from wind and rain but please check the weather and dress accordingly.

What to bring: Bring a lawn chair, clip board and writing utensil.

Planned schedule: 8:30 AM Registration; 9:00– 5:00 PM clinic (clinic will start promptly at 9AM)

Club Leaders are expected to advertise this clinic and to encourage parents and club instructors to attend. All Upper Level (those preparing for the HB and above) are strongly urged to attend. There is no cost to active pony club members. DC's please be sure that members attending this clinic are mature enough to sit for long periods of time and who will not be disruptive for others.
